

## Why Does DeVry Monitor Attendance?

Please read **BEFORE** you stop attending classes

- DeVry monitors attendance because it is a requirement of our Title IV Funding and directly affects our accreditation.
- DeVry monitors attendance because the government requires that students receiving financial aid maintain a certain percentage of their attempted courses and at least 6 credit hours per semester.
- If you miss more than 2 days from a class, you **may** receive an attendance dismissal from that class. (*See the Attendance Coordinator for explanation*)
- If you do not attend classes (or get dismissed), it could have an impact on your financial aid for the term.
  - You must **maintain at least 6 credit hours** per term to remain eligible for part-time financial aid status
  - You must **maintain at least 12 credit hours** per term to remain eligible for full-time financial aid status
