

Broadcasting News and Weather

Part One: News Broadcast:

Locate a news article on a city/county/area assigned by the professor. Prepare a two minute news report. Create your own “cue card.” You should read with expression appropriate to the story. Practice enough times to be able to read smoothly with no “uhs,” stops, or stalls. Full credit will be given only for smooth and professional delivery – you will be expected to repeat the presentation if errors occur.

Part Two: Weather Broadcast:

Look up the weather forecast for a specific area that the instructor will assign you. With the weather map displayed on the screen in the front of the room, show weather patterns that will dominate your assigned area. Give a five day forecast and comment on types of activities that would be appropriate to the weather.
